Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809)

Questa sinfonia, composta ed eseguita per la prima volta a Londra nel 1794, suscitò un tale entusiasmo di pubblico e critica da diventare uno dei maggiori successi della carriera di Haydn. La sinfonia venne denominata "Militare" per il largo uso che in essa si fece di strumenti delle bande militari.
