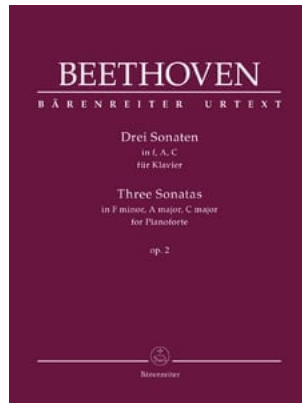




## *Sonata in A Major, Op. 2 No. 2: 4. Rondo*

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## Rondo

Grazioso
