Tarantella

Gioachino Rossini (1792-1868)

La tarantella è una danza caratteristica dell'Italia centro-meridionale, dal ritmo molto vivace. Secondo la tradizione popolare, questa danza poteva curare una forma di pazzia contratta da chi era stato morso dalla tarantola. Rossini, stimolato dal suo ritmo particolarmente brioso, compose questa tarantella per canto e pianoforte.
