First system of music (measures 1-4). The piece is in 4/4 time. The right hand (RH) starts with a half rest in measure 1, then plays a quarter note G4, a quarter note A4, a quarter note B4, and a quarter note C5 in measures 2-4. The left hand (LH) plays a half note G2, a half note F2, a half note E2, and a half note D2 in measures 1-4. The dynamic is *mf*. Fingerings are indicated: RH (1, 2, 1, 2) and LH (1, 2, 1, 2).

(LH played one octave lower)

Second system of music (measures 5-8). The RH plays a half note G4, a half note A4, a half note B4, and a half note C5 in measures 5-8. The LH plays a half note G2, a half note F2, a half note E2, and a half note D2 in measures 5-8. The dynamic is *mf*. Fingerings are indicated: RH (1, 2, 1, 2) and LH (1, 2, 1, 2).

Third system of music (measures 9-12). The RH plays a half note G4, a half note A4, a half note B4, and a half note C5 in measures 9-12. The LH plays a half note G2, a half note F2, a half note E2, and a half note D2 in measures 9-12. The dynamic is *f*. Fingerings are indicated: RH (1, 2, 1, 2) and LH (1, 2, 1, 2).

Fourth system of music (measures 13-16). The RH plays a half note G4, a half note A4, a half note B4, and a half note C5 in measures 13-16. The LH plays a half note G2, a half note F2, a half note E2, and a half note D2 in measures 13-16. The dynamic is *f*. Fingerings are indicated: RH (1, 2, 1, 2) and LH (1, 2, 1, 2).

Fifth system of music (measures 17-20). The RH plays a half note G4, a half note A4, a half note B4, and a half note C5 in measures 17-20. The LH plays a half note G2, a half note F2, a half note E2, and a half note D2 in measures 17-20. The dynamic is *mp*. Fingerings are indicated: RH (1, 2, 1, 2) and LH (1, 2, 1, 2).
