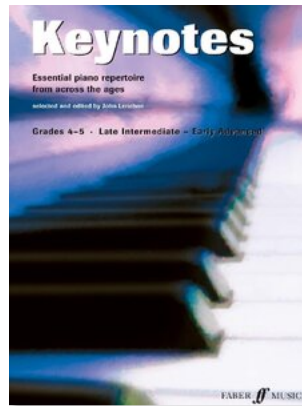

# Jig

The leading British composer of his time, Arne is now best-remembered for writing the famous patriotic song 'Rule Britannia'. His many harpsichord works include this lively jig.
