



Side Notes: The song "If You Could Hie to Kolob", as known in the LDS hymnal, has its roots from a popular English and Scottish ballad known as "Dives and Lazarus." The song was included in a collection of 305 ballads compiled by Francis James Child in the late nineteenth century, and published by Houghton Mifflin in 1882 and 1898.

The song is also a traditional Christmas carol and can be found as a folk song in various regions of the world. The words to the original English ballad are based on the story found in Luke 16:19-31.

Even though the melody is quite simple, this is one of my favorites. This arrangement sounds great with solo piano, but when I'm playing on my digital piano, I like adding in orchestra as I play.
