5. Præludium und Fughetta G-Dur *)

BWV 902

Præludium

First system of the Præludium, measures 1-3. The music is in G major (one sharp) and common time. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a rhythmic accompaniment with eighth notes.

Second system of the Præludium, measures 4-5. The right hand continues the melodic line with a slur over measures 4 and 5. The left hand maintains the eighth-note accompaniment.

Third system of the Præludium, measures 6-7. The right hand has a slur over measures 6 and 7. The left hand continues the eighth-note accompaniment.

Fourth system of the Præludium, measures 8-9. The right hand has a slur over measures 8 and 9. The left hand continues the eighth-note accompaniment.

Fifth system of the Præludium, measures 10-12. The right hand has a slur over measures 10 and 11, and a triplet of eighth notes in measure 12. The left hand continues the eighth-note accompaniment.
