1. Allegro assai

Measures 1-5 of the first system. The music is in G major (one sharp) and 2/4 time. The right hand features a series of eighth-note patterns, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes.

Measures 6-9 of the second system. The right hand continues with eighth-note patterns, and the left hand features a more active line with eighth-note runs and rests.
