'A great piece for telling a musical story – choose a historical period or character and let your imagination run riot. Once you have your story, invest time in your grammar and master that B-flat minor scale (a frequently neglected key). Start the piece itself with the left-hand melody, which will determine how much *molto* you can muster. An even line will need strong 4th and 5th fingers, and plenty of arm weight on the accents. Right-hand balance will be a challenge from bar 26 onwards, where melody and accompaniment will need to be clearly differentiated to keep the off-beats light and crisp. Take the piece at a gallop, but without letting it gallop away; metronome practice may well be in order. Finally, be really strict with the staccato, so that its perpetual spell is never broken.'
