She cuts a lonely and helpless figure gazing out of the coach window into the rain.

Slowly and freely (♩ = 60)

mp hesitantly hopeful

The first system of music consists of three measures. The right hand starts with a whole rest, followed by a half note chord (F4, A4, C5) and a half note chord (Bb4, D5, F5).
