## Præludium

The first system of the Præludium, measures 1-3. The music is in G major (one sharp) and common time. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a rhythmic accompaniment with eighth notes and chords.

The second system of the Præludium, measures 4-5. The right hand continues the melodic development with a sixteenth-note pattern, and the left hand maintains the accompaniment.

The third system of the Præludium, measures 6-7. The right hand has a long melodic line with a trill-like figure, and the left hand continues with eighth-note accompaniment.

The fourth system of the Præludium, measures 8-9. The right hand features a melodic line with a trill, and the left hand continues with eighth-note accompaniment.

The fifth system of the Præludium, measures 10-12. The right hand has a melodic line with a trill and a triplet of sixteenth notes. The left hand continues with eighth-note accompaniment.
