La Settima sinfonia fu completata nel 1812 e presentata per la prima volta in un concerto tenuto a beneficio dei soldati austriaci e bavaresi feriti nella battaglia di Hanau. I militari tedeschi decretarono al lavoro un grande successo e, seduta stante, venne replicato l'Allegretto.
