Italian-born Scarlatti's music was influenced by Spanish and Portuguese folk music, with tonal inflections based on the Phrygian mode giving many of his sonatas a guitar-like character. Scarlatti wrote 555 short, single-movement keyboard sonatas in total, most of which were composed in pairs. This sonata is a favourite to perform as a free choice in national and international competitions. The mood is melancholy in this piece and the rests are important: imagine they are an intake of breath before each phrase.
