Praeludium und Fuge E-Dur

BWV 854

Præludium 9.

Measures 1-2 of the Præludium. The music is in E major (three sharps) and 12/8 time. The right hand features a melodic line with grace notes, while the left hand provides a harmonic accompaniment with sustained notes and moving bass lines.
