5. Menuet polonais

The first system of the Minuet Polonaise, measures 1-5. The right hand features a melodic line with grace notes and slurs, while the left hand provides a steady bass accompaniment.

The second system of the Minuet Polonaise, measures 6-10. It includes a repeat sign at the end of the system, indicating the start of the first ending.

The third system of the Minuet Polonaise, measures 11-14. The right hand continues with a flowing melodic line, and the left hand maintains the accompaniment.

The fourth system of the Minuet Polonaise, measures 15-19. This system concludes the first ending with a repeat sign.

The fifth system of the Minuet Polonaise, measures 20-24. This system concludes the second ending with a repeat sign and a final cadence.

6. Bourrée

The first system of the Bourrée, measures 1-5. The right hand has a simple melodic line, and the left hand features a rhythmic accompaniment with rests in the first two measures.
